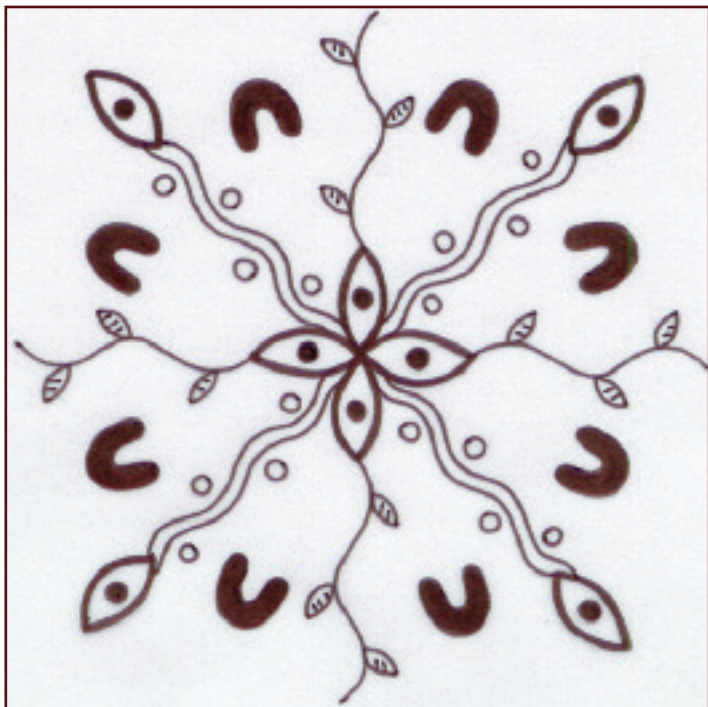

# Job Overview



Aboriginal Health Workers provide clinical and primary health care for individuals, families and community groups. They deal with patients, clients and visitors to hospitals and health clinics and assist with arranging health care in Aboriginal community health clinics.

Aboriginal Health Workers may choose to specialise in particular health areas such as optical, hearing, women's health or infant care.

Being of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent is a requirement for these qualifications.
