# Job Overview



As an aged care worker you would provide personal, physical and emotional support to older people who require assistance with daily living.

Aged care workers provide assistance with daily tasks such as showering, dressing, and eating, and often assist with outings and social activities. The level of assistance provided will depend on the ability and health of the client.

Aged care workers provide care either in a client's home, or in a residential care setting. They carry out their duties under direct or regular supervision within clearly defined care plans or organisational guidelines.

Traineeships in aged care are available.
