Job Overview



Early Childhood Educators provide education and care for preschool age children in centre based care and family day care settings. Their main roles are to help with the implementation of approved learning frameworks, support the children's wellbeing, maintain safe and caring environments and plan and create stimulating and enjoyable educational activities. Early Childhood Educators also work with children who have special needs.

The minimum qualification to become an Early Childhood Educator is the Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care.
