# Job Overview



Disability Support Workers support people with disability to engage with their community and live as independently as possible. Each person with a disability is unique, support is 'person centered' to recognise the specific needs of each individual.

The work may include supporting the person with a disability to: access and participate in recreational activities, undertake daily living activities, gain and keep employment, access and undertake education and training, and assist in the development of new skills.

Disability Support Workers need to enjoy working with people from different backgrounds, be willing to adapt to a variety of situations and be good communicators. It is possible to enter this occupation without formal qualifications; however, formal qualifications may improve your employment opportunities.
