Job Overview



Education assistants (also known as Teacher assistants or education support workers) help teaching staff in schools by performing teaching support duties such as care and supervision for children. Education assistants assist and participate in learning activities, prepare learning areas and activities, and provide individual assistance to students, particularly those with learning, physical or behavioural difficulties.

Education assistants are needed throughout the state, from the large schools in our cities and towns to the small remote schools in isolated country areas.

Education assistants can also specialise in working with special needs children.
