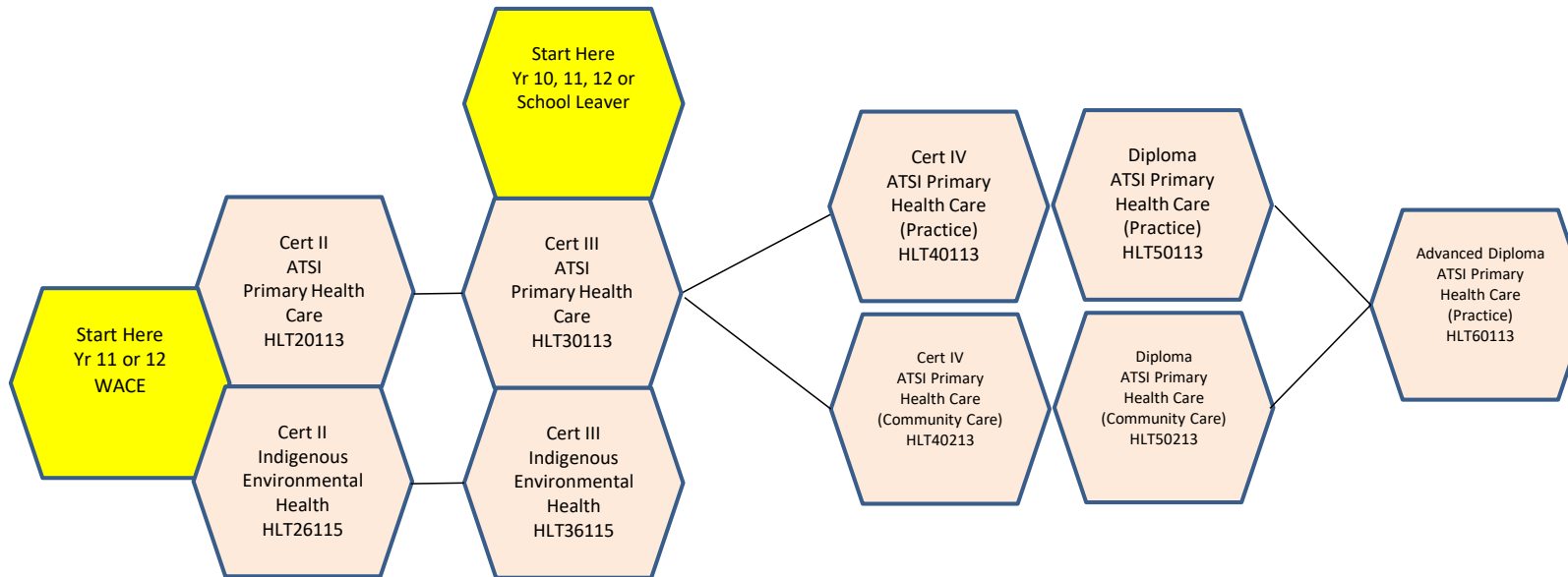


Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander Health Worker
